- ▣ Seaside 2040 General Plan Update Workshop – 6:00 (doors open at 5:30) to 8:00 at the Oldemeyer Center. It's your City – Show Up !

The Week That Was

- ▣ FY16/17 Budget Adopted – The City Council approved the next fiscal year's budget, with a \$65,687 budgeted surplus.
- ▣ New Website Unveiled, First Seaside Tweet – The new website (<http://www.ci.seaside.ca.us>) went live, and our Twitter account (@city_of_seaside) was activated. Instagram and Facebook will follow, in the months ahead.
- ▣ Youth Violence Prevention Manager Finalist Presentations – Two finalists for the YVPM position delivered presentations and the Steering Committee provided their input on the candidates. Thus, I'm in pursuit of their preferred candidate. Stop by the next Manifest for an update.
- ▣ Economic Development Program Manager Offer Extended – Gloria Stearns, with degrees in business, landscape architecture and urban planning, and presently working in economic development in Milwaukee, was offered a position. Expect a decision early this week.
- ▣ Regional Urban Design Guidelines Forwarded To FORA Board – The Task Force for the Regional Urban Design Guidelines concluded its work, recommending guidelines nearly two years in the making to the FORA Board, which will take up the recommendation at their June 10 meeting.
- ▣ Purchase Offer Received For Troia Building – Early Development Services, a child care business, submitted a purchase offer for the \$500,000 appraised value of the Troia Building. The offer is valid for 120 days and contingent on company being able to utilize the building as a child care facility.

📄 Youth Resource Center Co-locating With Youth Education Center – Following Council direction, staff has outlined how the Youth Resource Center will move in with the Youth Education Center. The move will be undertaken next week.

Rotation of Probationary Firefighters

In order to enhance and train the probationary firefighters with different Captains, they are rotated every four months to a different platoon. This month they are being rotated and all three platoons will have the opportunity to work side-by-side with them. There will be one more rotation at which time the probationary firefighters will remain on the platoon until such time there is a need to rotate personnel to accommodate the different fire department assignments. The rotation allows the probationary firefighter to be a well-rounded firefighter and gives them the opportunity work with different personnel.
