Updated Procedure For Modified Romberg Balance Test

Please Forward This Flyer To Your Department Training Manager, Traffic Supervisor, and any graduates of the DUI Seminar.

If you have a new point of contact for your agency please let us know.

The Standardized Three Test FST Battery validated by NHTSA consists of Nystagmus, Walk and Turn, and One Leg Stand. However, the DUI Seminar teaches two others used by DRE's. They are: Finger To Nose and the Modified Romberg Balance Test.

Recently, questions have arisen regarding the proper evaluation of the Modified Romberg Balance Test and what is considered a "normal" time estimate. Up until March 2014 the DUI Seminar has taught a normal time estimate was 30 seconds +/- 10 seconds (20 to 40 seconds). The IACP DRE pre-school manual provides direction as to the administration and evaluation of the test. The manual states the proper evaluation of the Modified Romberg time estimate is +/- 5 seconds (25 to 35 seconds). The manual further advised that caution should be used when correlating the time estimate to possible conclusions as to drug and/or alcohol influence as **there is currently no scientific data to support what is a normal time estimate**. All further DUI Seminars will instruct the IACPO DRE pre-school manual's direction of +/- 5 seconds (25 to 35 seconds).

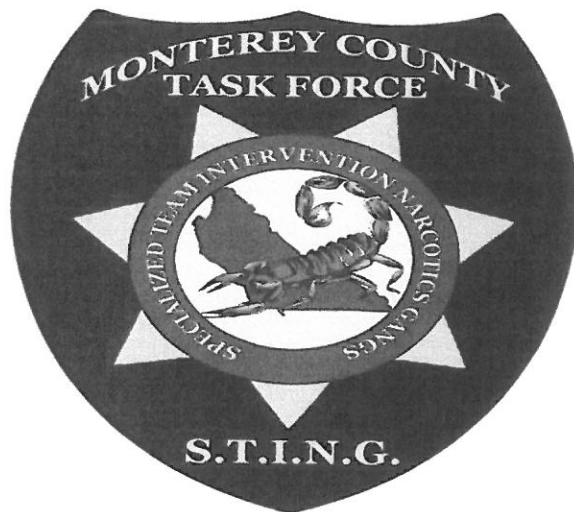
