In accordance with City procedures, the employee was immediately removed from the workplace as the Seaside Police Department began an investigation. In coordination with the Monterey County District Attorney's Office, the Seaside Police Department has conducted an investigation into this complaint and has forwarded the information gathered through the investigation to the District Attorney's Office.

I wanted to make you aware of this allegation and assure you that the City's first priority is for the safety and security of all children and adults that participate in the City's recreational programs.
