On 6/3/2018, at about 2000 hours, in the City of Seaside the driver of the vehicle depicted above stopped in front of victim's vehicle while in traffic, exited his vehicle and approached victim. The subject flashed a gold star badge at the victim and placed it back in his pocket and advised her he was a Police Officer. Subject ordered victim to pull over, demanded her driver license which she provided to him. He took it back to his car and returned a short time later, telling her he would not be giving her a ticket for her tinted windows today because he was off duty.

He was last seen driving the above vehicle westbound on San Pablo Ave from Laguna St in Seaside.

The driver of the vehicle was described as an adult Hispanic male in his 40's, about 5'5", with short hair wearing a dark blue jacket and dark blue pants. The vehicle appears to be a blue stock mid 2000's Honda Accord with tinted rear windows.
