B.J. Dolan began his service with the City of Seaside in January 1971, as a member of the Redevelopment Agency. He was elected Mayor of Seaside April 4, 1972. He served that office until April of 1976.

As Mayor he pursued many improvements for the Citizens of Seaside. The greatest of which was the placement of the Seaside Post Office and beautification of Fremont Boulevard. Also during his tenure the City developed the K-Mart Laguna Lake project, the land acquisition for the Library and the Del Monte Heights redevelopment area.

A man of magnetic personality, he listened to every citizen's viewpoint. He created an informative phone in radio program with renowned guests. He was dedicated to communicating with citizens.

The comradery among the City Council members during his term of office is now renowned. It was a time of greater strengths, directions and unity. The youngest commissioned Lt. Colonel of the U.S. Army, Mayor Dolan continues to reside with his wife Yolanda in the City of Seaside.
